Leader: I will extol you, O LORD, for you have drawn me up  
and have not let my foes rejoice over me.

### **Confession of Faith** -*Hus letter to Prague*

Leader: Master Jan Hus, servant of God, to all who in Prague are the elect of God, and who love our Lord Jesus Christ and his Word, wishes mercy and peace from God the Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ... Such has been towards us the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ, who recommended his disciples to say, into whatever house they entered, "Peace be with you!"

**Congregation: And when he raised up the dead, he said to them also, "Peace be with you!" And before his death, when conversing with his disciples, "I leave you my peace!"**

Leader: Wherefore, dearly beloved, I implore him to accord you that same peace. May peace be with you from the Lord, that you may live honestly and soberly—in calm, in justice, and in piety; and that you may conquer your enemies and those of God—the devil, the world, and the flesh.

**Congregation: Peace be with you from the Lord, that you may love each other, and your enemies also. Peace be with you, that you may listen to his Word with attention and humility. Peace be with you, that you may speak wisely and well, and that you may escape from your enemies.**

Leader: Peace be with you, that you may learn how to be silent with advantage; for whoever listens with humility never disputes evil-mindedly with any one; he who speaks prudently triumphs over the fool; and he who is silent in proper season, rarely acts against his conscience.

**All: On account of all these things, may peace, grace, and mercy be with you! peace, that you may have a tranquil conscience; grace, that your sins may be forgiven you; and mercy, that you may be delivered from unquenchable fire! May, then, peace be with you all... from God, the Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.**

**Sermon** - "Encouragement from Christ" - *Phil Davis*

**Hebrews 10:19-25**

<sup>19</sup> Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, <sup>20</sup> by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is,

through his flesh,<sup>21</sup> and since we have a great priest over the house of God,<sup>22</sup> let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.<sup>23</sup> Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.<sup>24</sup> And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,<sup>25</sup> not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

### **Židům 10:19-25**

<sup>19</sup> Bratři, díky Ježíšově krvi teď máme svobodný přístup do té pravé svatyně<sup>20</sup> tou novou a živou cestou, kterou nám otevřel skrze oponu, to jest jeho tělo.<sup>21</sup> Máme také velikého kněze nad Božím domem,<sup>22</sup> a proto přistupme s opravdovým srdcem, v plné jistotě víry, se srdcem očištěným od špatného svědomí a s tělem omytým čistou vodou.<sup>23</sup> Držme se neochvějné naděje, kterou vyznáváme – vždyť Ten, který dal zaslíbení, je věrný.<sup>24</sup> Věnujme se jedni druhým, povzbuzujme se k lásce a k dobrým skutkům<sup>25</sup> a neopouštějme naše společné shromáždění, jak mají někteří ve zvyku. Raději se napomínejme, a to tím více, čím více vidíte, že se blíží ten den.
