## Study Questions Week 4

### Worship



#### □ Day 1

📖 **Read Psalm 95**

🧠 **Answer (Write or Think):**

1. There are two distinct parts to this psalm (vv.1-7a and 7b-11). In the first part what are the reasons the psalmist tells us that we should worship?
2. How are we to worship God in this psalm? What posture(s) should we take?
3. What is the connection between the first section (worship) and second section (warning)? (Read Exodus 17:1-7 and Numbers 14:21-35 for background)
4. How does the psalm connect worship / rest with faith / belief?

🙏 **Pray** – Spend time (*consider kneeling!*):

Asking God for a heart that is marked by belief and trust,  
Resting in the character of God,  
Worshiping God with the words from vv.1-7a.

#### □ Day 2

📖 **Read John 4:19-26**

🧠 **Answer (Write or Think):**

1. Whom is Jesus speaking to (see vv.1-18 for context)? Why is this important?
2. What are some of the things that Jesus tells her about new forms of worship?
3. What do you think it means to worship in “spirit and in truth”? (See also Philippians 3:3, Romans 12:1)
4. Jesus tells the woman that he is ‘living water.’ How does this comfort you today?

🙏 **Pray** – Spend time:

Thanking God for being able to worship Him wherever you are.

Choose 1-2 worship songs to listen to today (use the list on the back for ideas!).

## □ Day 3

📖 **Choose any psalm from Psalm 96-100**

🗨️ **Answer (Write or Think):**

1. What are the reasons the psalmist tells us to worship?
2. What are the ways the psalmist tells us to worship?
3. What are some aspects of God that move you to praise Him today?
4. What are some specific things/people/circumstances that you want to thank God for today?

🙏 **Pray** – Slowly, out loud, read your psalm one more time, out loud, replacing “I” instead of “we” when applicable.
